Any student whose acquired credit at Kansas State University or any other institution began in Fall 1997 or later will be obligated to meet UGE requirements.

**The minimum UGE requirements for programs in the College of Human Ecology are outlined below. All requirements for 1) number of credits, 2) distribution of credits, and 3) levels of credits must be met.**

**The minimum number of UGE credits to be completed at KSU is based upon total number of completed transfer credit hours accepted at KSU.** Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate Programs (IB), College Level Examination Program (CLEP) and Defense Activity for Non-traditional Education Support (DANTES) credits may be considered "transfer credits" for purposes of the UGE Policy for Students Transferring Credit to Kansas State University.

*Courses must be completed in **four subject areas** and **must include 6 cr. at 300-level or higher.**\**
- \_\_\_\_\_ 12 (08-29 transfer credits accepted by KSU)  
*Courses must be completed in **four subject areas** and **must include 6 cr. at 300-level or higher.**\**
- \_\_\_\_\_ 09 (30-44 transfer credits accepted by KSU)  
*Courses must be completed in **three subject areas** and **must include 6 cr. at 300-level or higher.**\**
- \_\_\_\_\_ 06 (45 or more transfer credits accepted by KSU)  
*Courses must be completed in **two subject areas** and **6 cr. must be at 300-level or higher.**\**
