

College of Human Ecology Outstanding Senior Student

Research/Creative Activity Award

The Outstanding Student Research/Creative Activity Award is given to a graduating senior whose research or creative activity has made a significant contribution to his or her field of study.

Students (self-nomination), faculty, and staff are encouraged to nominate outstanding graduating seniors for this award.

Selection Criteria:

1. Quality, significance, and extent of research or creative accomplishments
2. Communication to appropriate audiences (should not be a class assignment presentation)
3. Good academic standing (not on academic warning, minimum gpa of 2.5)

Nomination Process:

1. A letter from the nominator and a statement from the student describing in detail the quality, significance and extent of the research or creative activity; and the methods by which it was communicated to appropriate audiences.
2. A brief description of 250 to 500 words from the nominee outlining his/her accomplishments while a student at Kansas State University (*This information will be used in College of Human Ecology print materials and website*)
3. Current resume from the student

Engagement Award

The Outstanding Student Engagement Award is given to a graduating senior who has made exemplary contributions that impact the well-being of the community or individuals in the community.

Students (self-nomination), faculty, and staff are encouraged to nominate outstanding graduating seniors for this award.

Selection criteria:

1. Quality, significance, and impact of engagement
2. Activities may be at the local, regional, national or international level
3. Good academic standing (not on academic warning, minimum gpa of 2.5)

Nomination Process:

1. A letter from the nominator and a statement from the student describing the impact of the individual's contributions on the community/setting/population served.
2. A brief description of 250 to 500 words from the nominee providing detailed description of the engagement activity while a student at Kansas State University. (*This information will be used in College of Human Ecology print materials and website*)
3. Current resume from the student

Leadership Award

The Outstanding Student Leadership Award is given to an individual who has exhibited excellence in leadership. Students will be recognized for their contributions to the campus, college, program, and professional organizations.

Students (self-nomination), faculty, and staff are encouraged to nominate outstanding graduating seniors for this award.

Selection Criteria:

1. Demonstrate depth of involvement through growth in responsibility, commitment, and/or leadership
2. Demonstrate exemplary leadership through their involvement
3. Represents the positive attributes of leadership through ability to motivate others, collaboration, integrity, and balance
4. Student nominees must be in good academic standing

Nomination Process:

1. A letter from the nominator and a statement from the student describing in detail the quality, significance and extent of the leadership involvement
2. A brief description of 250 to 500 words from the nominee outlining their accomplishments while a student at Kansas State University (*This information will be used in the print materials and on the website for the College of Human Ecology*)
3. Current resume from the student
